Engineering Technician I

The Greater Augusta Utility District is a non-profit public utility that owns and operates a water, sewer and stormwater utility which provides service to multiple communities. These services include sewer collection, wastewater treatment, stormwater collection, drinking water supply and fire protection.

Responsibilities of the Engineering Tech I include administrative and technical work associated with the water, sewer and storm systems, Dig-Safe utility locates, cross connection control, asset management, Dig Safe, construction inspection, project design, field layout, researching customer issues, computer aided drafting (CAD), geographic information system (GIS) data input/output, hydrant flow testing, grease interceptor inspections, and maintenance of location records. Work is performed under general supervision with periodic review to ensure satisfactory performance of work.

The successful candidate will have an Associate's Degree in the field of Civil, Sanitary, or Environmental Engineering with a utility specialty preferred, or equivalent experience in the field. Experience in construction activities and a basic understanding of engineering is required. Must have a Class C Maine driver's license, as well as have or be able to obtain a Class II Water Distribution Operator's License, a Class II Water Treatment Operator's License, and a Class II Wastewater Collections System Operators License within 18 months of hire. Certification as a Cross Connection Control Surveyor and Backflow Prevention Device Tester within 6 months from the date of hire is required.

This is a full-time, non-exempt position with a comprehensive benefit package, including retirement, family medical/dental insurance and generous leave benefits.

Pay range is \$46,052 to 59,864 annualized.
