TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR I

The City of South Portland is currently seeking a full time wastewater treatment plant Operator I to join our Water Resource Protection team. This position performs the day to day operation and control of the City's wastewater treatment facility and pumping stations. The selected candidate will work under the direct supervision of the Chief Operator.

The incumbent will perform routine preventative maintenance tasks, housekeeping duties and repair functions at the plant and pump stations. The Operator I will be responsible for completing routine laboratory testing on treatment plant influent and effluent samples, operating the sludge processing equipment and the mixing of required chemicals.

Ideal applicants should have strong knowledge of the equipment, facilities, processes, methods and procedures used in wastewater treatment operations and maintenance activities. Training is available. A valid Maine Driver's license is required. A Maine DEP Grade 2 Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator's Certificate is required within 2 years of date of hire. Ideal candidates must have the availability to be on-call in rotation with other operators to be considered.
